Tag Selection Guide



Heavy Plastic Tags

- Material: Toughest tag on the market, 80-lb. pull strength exceeds OSHA standards
- Resistance: Fully laminated, resists grease, grime, chemicals and moisture
- **Grommet:** Heavy-duty 3/8" ID metal prevents rips so your tag stays put
- Write On: Write on, wipe off, erasable for easy re-use — save on constant replacements



Vinyl Tags

- Material: Extra durable to withstand extreme conditions
- **Resistance:** Weatherproof, resists water and chemicals in harsh environments
- Grommet: Resists tearing: metal eyelet won't rip
- Write On: Write on, throw away, one time use for temporary jobs



Heavy Cardstock Tags

- Material: Durable 13-pt. cardstock
- Resistance: Heavy-duty paper for dry, indoor use
- Grommet: Strong, reinforced fiber patch resists tugs and tears
- Write On: Write on, throw away, one time use for temporary jobs

Fastening Methods



Permanently-Locking Fasteners

Permanent use, cannot be removed unless cut.




Reusable Fastener

Locks in place yet able to remove and reuse.




Releasable Tab Fasteners

Reusable and adjustable, locking/unlocking tab.



Chrome-Plated Pins

Tougher than wire, quicker than string. Reusable.



Elastic String

Stretches to provide a snug fit.



Beaded Chain

Attractive and strong.



Stainless Steel Wire

Strong material, twist and stays in place.
